What is it?

The Celtic Arts Festival is an afternoon of Celtic music, dance, and culture.

In addition to our own 75-voice choir, the afternoon will feature rotating performances by the following:

- TINSMITH - a folk band fusing traditional music with modern influences
- VES JAMMERS - Auditioned ensemble of Vienna Elementary School's students (3rd – 6th grade)
- RICH FOLLETT - singer, songwriter, poet and minstrel
- THE IRISH BREAKFAST BAND - 20+ member traditional Ceili band and dancers from the DC area
- KATHERINE HUGHES - a traditional celtic dancer
- JOHN AND WILLIAM HUGHES - father and son bagpipers
- EAMMON CAROLAN - Irish fiddle

The festival will be an open house atmosphere. For the public, one ticket buys admittance to the whole afternoon.

How much is it for vendors?

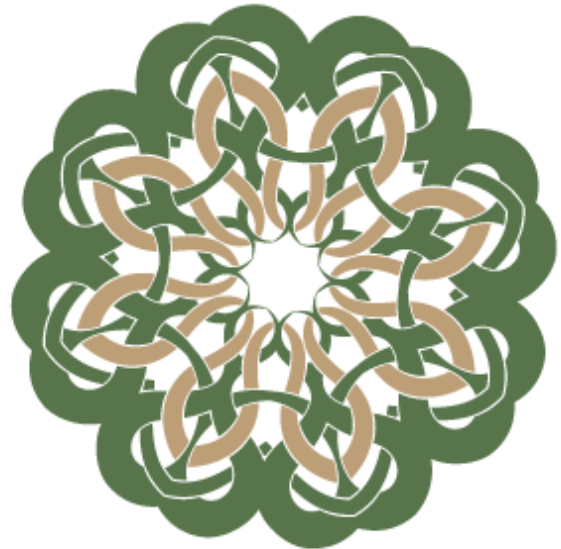
You pay \$50 for your booth.
